At present, all lessons will remain online as tutors are not allowed to be on campus and mix between schools. These lessons will be scheduled after school or weekends at home.

Additional information regarding Covid-19 precautions

- Tutors will have the use of 2 rooms. Lessons will rotate between the 2 rooms to ensure deep cleaning between each Instrumental Lesson.
- An on-site cleaner will be available in the Music department at all times to sanitise door handles, doors and shared instruments/equipment.
- Learners will make their way to Instrumental Lessons independently using the stairways.
- Learners must use their own instrument, music and accessories within reason. This is to limit contact between tutors and learners.
- We will be using the larger music studios, rehearsal and Secondary music classroom to ensure safe distancing.
- Learners will be encouraged to sanitise their hands prior to lessons.
- A 2-metre distance is required for wind, brass and voice lessons.

All details are subject to change and will be reviewed weekly. We will continue to follow the Government guidelines and keep you updated.
