We are delighted that your son/daughter/ward has expressed an interest in joining us as a delegate to:

THAIMUN V at Concordian International School (CIS), Bangkok Thailand

Accompanied by MUN co-director Susan MacIntosh, learners will stay at the Bangna Pride hotel and travel to the conference each day by coach. All meals and snacks are provided except for the evening meal and learners are advised to bring approximately 65SGD in Thai Baht to purchase these items.

In addition you will be given a green Permission and Medical/dietary needs form and this needs to be returned by **Monday 5 March 2018**.

We are planning to leave around midday on Friday 30 March, and return in the evening of Monday 2 April. We will share flight times with you when these are available. Delegates need to arrange their own way to and from Singapore Changi Airport.

The cost of the trip is approximately \$895 SGD. Please note that a non-refundable deposit of \$300 SGD and \$70 USD conference fee must be made to the cashier before **Monday 15 January**. The final payment will be due on **Monday 26 February**.

How do I pay?

Nexus International School (Singapore) accepts fee payments in cash, cheque, credit/debit card, bank transfer and NETS. Cash and credit card payments must be made in person at the Cashier at Nexus International School (Singapore) during office hours between 8.00am and 5.30pm from Monday to Thursday and between 8.00am and 5.00pm on Friday.
