

IB SUBJECT SELECTION OPTIONS AY 2023/2024

The curriculum for Year 12 and Year 13 contains a compulsory core of subjects. The core subjects are:

Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS); Extended Essay (EE) and Theory of Knowledge (TOK)

In addition to the core subjects, learners must choose six other subjects.

- One must be chosen from each "block" and no subject may be chosen more than once.
- IB Diploma candidates must study 3 subjects at Higher Level and three subjects at Standard Level. This will be determined during the induction period in discussion with the IBDP Coordinator.
- It is our intention to offer these courses for the academic years mentioned above but course viability will depend on learner numbers for the course.

Once a student has commenced his/her chosen subject, reconsideration of the subject choices must happen within the first few weeks. In any circumstance, the change of subject requires careful consideration by the Head of School and IBDP Coordinator.

Subjects should be chosen based on their relevance to learners' future study, achievement and enjoyment and not because of friendship groups.

^{**} Language ab initio is for learners who have minimal or no prior experience of the language
